Dear Brothers,

Greetings from the Alumni Board. If this is the first correspondence you have received from Lehigh Delta Chi in some time, rest assured we are still actively working on a number of issues. The purpose of this letter is two-fold – to update you on current happenings and to vote on amending the Chapter's By-Laws.

To begin with, the annual open meeting of the Alumni Board of Trustees will be held Saturday, November 18th at 10 am in Lehigh in the University Center (room # T.B.A.) All members are invited to attend.

Since last year's Lehigh-Lafayette Cocktails were such a great success, I'd like to informally plan a get together for this year's game at Lafayette. Many of the Delta Chi alumni will be gathering for drinks at Porter's Pub in Easton (7th Street & Northampton Ave.) Nothing is formal - just a place to eat and drink!

As far as standard business goes, tax filings were taken care of as well as our final cleanout of items in storage at Lehigh. All remaining items are now in the care of Russ Mallett, Marty Smith, and myself. Again, my thanks to them for their efforts.

The main purpose of this writing is to vote on amending the BY-Laws. You may not be aware, but the Chapter has been operating on By-laws dating back to 1970. Needless to say, these are outdated in certain areas. With the help of legal counsel, we have proposed changes. Specifically, the section on investing/management of the Building Fund is outdated, considering today's investment environment. Another major change, actually an addition, is the issue of indemnification. Again, this was precipitated by the legal environment that exists these days. Most of the other changes in the By-Laws are minor. We thought we'd make the changes all at once rather than piece at a time. I'd like to ask each of you to carefully read over the changes and respond with a vote. I'd like to stress that the Board and our legal counsel has spent considerable time going over these changes, so that these By-Laws will last for a long time. According to our By-Laws, any changes to them require a $\frac{3}{4}$ affirmative vote of all members in good standing. As defined, anyone who returns his ballot is a member in good standing.

Also, two Board members, Bill Glaser and I are up for re-election. Nominations were also taken. Please vote up to three members for the three positions available on the Board.

The time for our eligibility for re-colonization is fast approaching. Last fall, Emory Zimmers was kind enough to discuss formulation of strategies to re-colonize. A few members volunteered to meet and come up with three proposals. The Board believes in order for our re-colonization efforts to be successful, it must be led by a separate entity, dare I say committee, which has only one focus and goal. Aside from strategizing, part of

this involves re-establishing a relationship with the University and working with International Headquarters. We all want to have a house again at Lehigh – but it will not happen without *your* effort. Please contact me if you would like to be part of this group.

I also mentioned forming a Lehigh Delta Chi Alumni Chapter. The purpose of this would be more for social events (parties, tailgates, etc.) and possibly newsletters. If anyone has an interest in taking lead on this please let me know.

Lastly, I'd like to re-announce that Derrick Chin '92 has set up a web site for Lehigh Delta Chi where we can post messages, calendar events, photo albums, and an e-mail list. So far 40 members have signed on. Please, I urge everyone with internet access to sign on (it's free and easy!) – all correspondences that are not sent out by mail will be posted on this site. This could also be the place where the Delta Dispatch can make its return.
